Key Responsibilities

- **Dual Membership:** Serve as a member of the BOA Research Committee and the Specialty Advisory Committee (SAC).
- **Advisory Role:** Provide guidance to the SAC on academic and research competencies required for Certification of Completion of Training (CCT).
- **Communication and Support:** Act as a conduit for research-related concerns from trainees, supporting their access to research opportunities and addressing barriers to engagement.
- **Curriculum Development:** Assist in aligning research and academic competencies with the evolving Trauma and Orthopaedics curriculum.
- **CESR Application Assessment:** Contribute to the evaluation of Portfolio (CESR) Pathway.
- **Program Liaison:** Opportunity to become a SAC liaison member for a training program, participating in Annual Review of Competency Progression (ARCP) panels.

Time Commitment

- **Committee Meetings:** Attend approximately eight meetings annually across the Research Committee and SAC. These will be a mixture of F2F & virtual meetings
- **Additional Duties:** Allocate time for CESR application assessments and optional training program liaison responsibilities.
